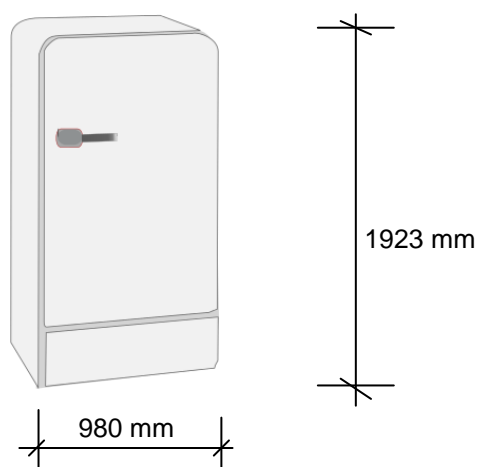
Its volume is **805 l**/ 815 l/ 850 l.

Tapescript (*Setting: an electrical appliance store. An old man walks in.*)

Saleswoman: Good morning. May I help you ?

*Old man: Yes, actually. I'm looking to buy a **new fridge**. **My old one just broke**, and I would like to replace it with a fridge that has an automatic ice maker and other nifty, newfangled features. Like lots of shelves. And a light.*

Saleswoman: Well sure, sir. This one here is our only fridge with an ice maker, but it's on sale for half price as well, so it's probably your best option anyway. It's now only **399 Euros**.

*Old man: Ok, as long as it's big enough, I'll take it. It says **805 litres** here. That should be able to hold enough beer. Oh it has a nice handle. The height inside is **1, 774 millimetres**? It's perfect for me! It's a little too high for my wife, but luckily I do all the cooking anyway. Oh good! There are six shelves in the door. Our old one just had two shelves which are broken. So six shelves is a big improvement. I'm not sure we'll need all six main shelves though...can you take them out?*

Saleswoman: Pardon? Oh, yes, the shelves can be removed. I'd like to tell you the measurements of the space. This fridge's dimensions are: 980mm x 1, 923mm x 1,001mm. Will that fit in your kitchen?

*Old man: Yep, it should be no problem. You said **980mm wide x 1, 923mm high x 1,001mm deep**?*

Saleswoman: Yes, but the weight is 164.3 kilograms. Will that be alright for your truck? **We can deliver the fridge this afternoon** if **164.3 kilograms** is too much weight on the truck, or if you want a hand putting it together.

Old man: That sounds ideal. I don't think my little truck can fit a fridge that large anyway. I'll just pay now. Before I forget, will I need lightbulbs for inside, or do they come with it?

Saleswoman: It's an LED light on the interior, but the bulbs come with it. They're in the box. Could you leave your address and telephone number at customer services, please?

Old man: Of course. Thank you, miss. You've been very helpful. Bye!

Saleswoman: Bye. Have a nice day.
