

Suggested tasks for using the audio guide

The audio guide comprises 27 stations. It is therefore advisable to divide the tasks within the visitor group and combine them into an overall result at the end.

- A pre-determined number of stations should be worked on per group.
- The stations are assigned directly to the groups beforehand.
- There can be different tasks within the groups: Photographers, reporters, interviewers, editors (researching, transcribing, etc.), draughtsmen, etc.

Suggested tasks:

- 1. design a flyer for each station, which could be displayed for visitors to take away.
- 2. write a report on the station.

- 3. Write an article for the school newspaper about your visit to the German Toy Museum.
- 4. Create a radio report about the German Toy Museum.
- 5. Create a puzzle booklet or a task booklet about the German Toy Museum for primary school pupils.
- 6. Make a comic strip about the visit to the German Toy Museum.
- 7. Create a set of knowledge cards about the German Toy Museum.

Suggest text module at the end of the task:
